

WOMENS RESOLUTION - 2008 AGM

WHEREAS; THE WOMEN'S DELEGATION MET AT A DULY CONSTITUTED ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING IN CAMBRIDGE BAY, NUNAVUT, OCTOBER 21-23, 2008 TO VOICE THEIR CONCERNS AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO IMPROVE CONDITIONS IN THEIR COMMUNITIES; AND

WHEREAS; THE WOMEN PRESENTED THEIR REPORT TO THE ASSEMBLY WHICH INCLUDED THE FOLLOWING:

- NEED FOR FUNDING FOR TRADITIONAL SEWING PROGRAMS AND ASSISTANCE IN SEEKING FUNDS TO ADEQUATELY OPERATE THE SEWING CENTRES, AND
- NEED FOR TIMELY MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS WITH DOCTORS AND OTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS, AND
- NEED FOR ADEQUATELY FUNDED WOMENS SHELTERS IN ALL COMMUNITIES, AND
- NEED FOR ADEQUATELY FUNDED MENS SHELTERS IN ALL COMMUNITIES, AND
- FOR THE KITIKMEOT INUIT ASSOCIATION TO CONSIDER RENAMING THE FEAST AND ENTERTAINMENT NIGHT DURING FUTURE AGM'S TO THE "JIMMY KOMAKSIUT ENTERTAINMENT NIGHT".
- NEED FOR WELLNESS CENTRES TO BE ESTABLISHED IN ALL KITIKMEOT COMMUNITIES THAT PRESENTLY DO NOT HAVE ONE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE KITIKMEOT INUIT ASSOCIATION CONTINUE TO ADDRESS THESE ISSUES BY LOBBYING THE APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS, AND DETERMINE WHICH ITEMS CAN BE IMPLEMENTED BY THE KITIKMEOT INUIT ASSOCIATION, AND WHERE APPLICABLE, SEEK FUNDING WHERE APPROPRIATE,
