

YOUTH RESOLUTION - 2008 AGM

WHEREAS; THE YOUTH DELEGATION MET AT A DULY CONSTITUTED ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING IN CAMBRIDGE BAY, NUNAVUT, OCTOBER 21-23, 2008 TO VOICE THEIR CONCERNS AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO IMPROVE CONDITIONS IN THEIR COMMUNITIES; AND

WHEREAS; THE YOUTH PRESENTED THEIR REPORT TO THE THE KITIKMEOT INUIT ASSOCIATION ASSEMBLY WHICH INCLUDED THE FOLLOWING:

- NEED FOR RECREATION EQUIPMENT IN BAY CHIMO AND BATHURST INLET, AND
- NEED TO RE-ENFORCE THE RESOLUTION FOR OPENING A STORE IN BAY CHIMO, AND
- NEED FOR A HOSTEL IN CAMBRIDGE BAY FOR STUDENTS FROM OUT OF TOWN TO RESIDE IN WHILE BEING EDUCATED IN CAMBRIDGE BAY, AND
- NEED TO DEVELOP AN OUTWARD BOUND PROGRAM FOR INUIT YOUTH, AND
- NEED OF RESOURCES FOR COMPLETION OF YOUTH CENTRES/SHELTERS AND FOR HIRING OF YOUTH COORDINATORS IN ALL COMMUNITIES, AND
- NEED FOR MORE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMMING FOR ELDERLY AND YOUTH, AND
- NEED OF A YOUTH AWARENESS PROGRAM IN KUGAARUK REGARDING THE UPCOMING LIQUOR PLEBISCITE, AND
- NEED TO ADDRESS THE ISSUE OF YOUTH POVERTY AND HEALTHY NUTRITION IN ALL KITIKMEOT COMMUNITIES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE KITIKMEOT INUIT ASSOCIATION CONTINUE TO ADDRESS THESE ISSUES BY LOBBYING THE APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS, AND DETERMINE WHICH ITEMS CAN BE IMPLEMENTED BY THE KITIKMEOT INUIT ASSOCIATION, AND WHERE APPLICABLE, SEEK FUNDING WHERE APPROPRIATE,
