*Kitikmeot Inuit Association's (KIA) goal is to train Instructors for future employment opportunities to deliver First Aid courses during work weeks and on weekends, as requested by communities and organizations!*

*Successful participants will have contracting opportunities in the future to deliver First Aid training.*

## WHO CAN APPLY?

**Inuit registered under the Nunavut Agreement, residing in the Kitikmeot Region and planning to remain in the region who are:**

- 18 years of age or older, unemployed or underemployed (applicants under 18 are eligible for consideration only if they have graduated); and
- Willing and available to deliver programming in Kitikmeot Communities as needed

**Please Note: Priority will be given to eligible Inuit registered under the Nunavut Agreement - Kitikmeot Region. Strong literacy skills are required to learn and effectively deliver the information to future participants, and to complete the course paperwork and stay organized with it.**
