APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

- Be 18 years of age or older, and be unemployed or underemployed, and resident Kitikmeot Inuit;
- Grade 9 level - literacy, basic practical problem solving, and math skills (addition, subtraction, division, multiplication, and percentage);
- **Able to pass a physical health test**, drug and alcohol test (including mouth swab for cannabis);
- Prepared to work in underground mining situations and work outdoors in adverse weather, hike and carry heavy loads;
- Work 12 -13 hours per day a mining camp for 2-3 weeks at a time.

HOW TO APPLY

- Submit **resume and short letter** telling why you want to be accepted into the program.

Candidates who participate in and successfully complete Part 1 will meet the primary prerequisite requirements for accessing the Goose Mine, as well as most of the basic requirements needed to access a mine site.

Candidates selected for the practicums will have the opportunity to obtain full-time employment with Geotech Ekutak as a drill assistant or in other drill support roles.
